We are collecting donations for Trent Hill this month. Donation boxes are located in the hallway next to the church office. If you have questions, call Judy at 843-858-0338.

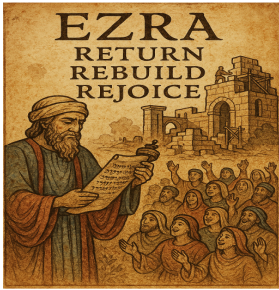
ATTENTION ALL LADIES!
