VBS 2026—Rome: Paul and the Underground Church

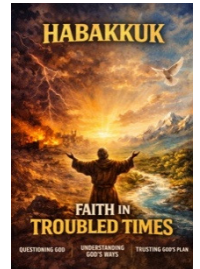
