

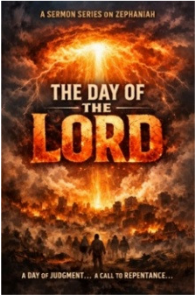

SERMON SERIES



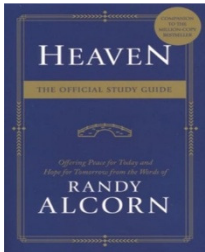
Join us as we explore the Book of Zephaniah. Zephaniah is a short, three-chapter prophetic book in the Old Testament that warns of a looming global judgment known as the "Day of the Lord," but ultimately concludes with a glorious promise of restoration and joy. Written during the reign of King Josiah (640–609 BC), Zephaniah prophesied to push the nation of Judah away from rampant idolatry and back toward the worship of the one true God. Like the Judeans of the day, we, too, sometimes are guilty of idolatry. In this series, Zephaniah will remind you how seriously God takes your life and your relationship with Him. And if you have failed, remember the message of Zephaniah 3—God is always a God of restoration and hope.
